3. Clause 20 (Additional amount for telephone installation or reconnection)

3.1 Before "cost of installing or reconnecting one private telephone", insert "reasonable".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/3

Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 505, Disturbance Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance for miscellaneous removal costs to members of the Australian Defence Force who move from one locality to another at official expense.

Clause 20 of Determination 505 authorises an additional amount of Disturbance Allowance equal to the cost of installing or reconnecting one private telephone in the new residence.

This Determination amends clause 20 by limiting reimbursement to the reasonable cost of such installation or reconnection.
