1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/30.

2. Amendment

2.1 Determination 2607, Recreation Leave Bonus, as amended¹, is amended as set out in this Determination.

3. Clause 2 (Definitions)

3.1 Definition of "average weekly earnings":

Delete the definition, substitute:

"'average weekly earnings', in relation to a leave year, means the average weekly total earnings (original estimates series) for all male employees issued by the Australian Statistician for the specified pay period occurring in February of the leave year;"

3.2 Definition of "the Statistician":

Delete the definition.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/30
Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 2607, Recreation Leave Bonus, sets out the conditions on which recreation leave bonus is granted to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

This Determination amends the definition of "average weekly earnings" to reflect a change in the basis of the survey used by the Australian Bureau of Statistics in deriving this figure, which is referred to in authorising the maximum amount of recreation leave bonus payable each year.

The redundant definition of "the Statistician" is consequently repealed.
