EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/31

*Defence Act 1903*

Determination 1907, Pet Relocation Expenses Allowance, provides for the payment of an allowance to a member of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) to reimburse the cost of transporting and kennelling a pet when the member has been granted a removal at Commonwealth expense.

The Allowance is related to a similar entitlement provided within Australia for officers of the Australian Public Service (APS) under Public Service Board Determination 1983/10 made under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*.

This Determination amends Determination 1907 by specifying that entitlement to the allowance is restricted to those members who are granted a removal within Australia. This reflects the intention of both the ADF and APS provisions in regard to eligibility to the allowance.
