1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1994/37.

2. Commencement

2.1 This Determination commences on the day on which Overseas Defence Determination 1994/36 commences.

3. Amendment

3.1 Determination 1503, Cancelled Posting Expenses, as amended¹, is amended as set out in clause 4.

4. Clause 2 (Definitions)

4.1 Definition of "relevant determination":

Delete "Determination 2002, Loss on Sale of Motor Vehicle on Posting Overseas", substitute "the provisions of Overseas Defence Determination 1994/36 relating to loss on sale of a motor vehicle".

5. Repeal of Determination 2002

5.1 Determination 2002, Loss on Sale of Motor Vehicle on Posting Overseas, as amended², is repealed.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/37

Defence Act 1903

Overseas Defence Determination 1994/36 authorises a number of entitlements for members of the Australian Defence Force on long-term posting overseas, by reference to the Public Service determination authorising the same entitlements for officers of the Australian Public Service.

One of these entitlements relates to expenses incurred by members on disposal of possessions. This includes reimbursement for loss on sale of a motor vehicle prior to posting, which was formerly authorised by Determination 2002, Loss on Sale of a Motor Vehicle on Posting Overseas.

Clause 5 of this Determination repeals the redundant Determination 2002.

Clauses 3 and 4 make a minor consequential amendment.

Clause 2 provides for the Determination to commence on the same day as Overseas Defence Determination 1994/36.
