**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/39**

*Defence Act 1903*

Overseas Defence Determination 1994/38 provides for various general and post-specific conditions of service for members of the Australian Defence Force on long-term posting overseas.

Most of those provisions were formerly set out in Determination 3901, Complementary Allowances Payable to Member Serving on Duty Overseas, which is now redundant.

This Determination repeals Determination 3901 from the day on which Determination 1994/38 commences.
