### 1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/42.

### 2. Amendment

2.1 Determination 511, Extra Tuition Allowance, as amended<sup>1</sup>, is amended as set out in this Determination.

### 3. Clause 4 (Extra Tuition Allowance)

3.1 Paragraph 4(b):

Delete the paragraph, substitute:

"(b) the child is attending primary school or secondary school;"

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/42**

*Defence Act 1903*

Determination 511, Extra Tuition Allowance, provides assistance for a member who, following a removal at public expense, arranges extra tuition for a child because the child is experiencing education difficulties at a new school. The member may be reimbursed up to 85% of the cost of the tuition for a maximum period of six weeks.

This Determination broadens the entitlement to include all primary and secondary school education. Previously, eligibility for the allowance was restricted to children in secondary school and the last or second-last year of primary school.
