EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/43

Defence Act 1903

Overseas Defence Determination 1994/38 (the Principal Determination) authorises miscellaneous conditions of overseas service for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF), including conditions relating to service at specific posts.

Clause 4 of the Principal Determination formerly provided for a payment to members serving as Head, Australian Defence Staff in London and in Washington DC. The payment was for the cost of all consumable minor household maintenance supplies beyond the amount that those members would be required to contribute if they were Heads of Post for the purpose of the corresponding Australian Public Service (APS) provision. The APS provision was repealed by Public Service Determination 1994/160 of 26 September 1994.

This Determination repeals clause 4 of the Principal Determination on the basis of advice from the ADF that no payments to ADF members have been necessary in recent years.
