DETERMINATION UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/45.

2. Amendment

2.1 Determination No 501, Education Allowance, as amended¹, is amended as set out in this Determination.

3. Clause 3A (Approving authority)

3.1 Delete the clause, substitute the following:

"3A. For the purposes of this Determination, the approving authority shall be the Assistant Chief of the Defence Force (Personnel)."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/45

Defence Act 1903

Determination 501, Education Allowance, provides for payment of an allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) who are posted from one locality to another locality within Australia and who arrange for their child to attend a secondary school in a locality other than the locality of posting to prevent serious disruption to the child's secondary schooling.

Clause 3 of this Determination amends Determination 501 by substituting the Assistant Chief of the Defence Force (Personnel) for the approving authority which exercised certain discretions in relation to payment of the allowance. Administrative changes have resulted in the function being transferred from the First Assistant Secretary, Human Resources Division of the Department of Defence to an officer of similar status within the Headquarters of the Australian Defence Force.
