



OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/51

DETERMINATION UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

I, MERYL ANNETTE STANTON, First Assistant Secretary, Government Authorities and Defence Division, Department of Industrial Relations, acting under a delegation made by the Minister for Industrial Relations under Defence Force Regulation 72A, make the following Determination under section 58B of the Defence Act 1903.

1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1994/51.

2. Definitions

2.1 In this Determination -

"dependant" has the same meaning as in the relevant Public Service determination;

"relevant Public Service determination" means Public Service Determination 1994/162 as in force from time to time.

3. Assisted leave travel

3.1 A member on long-term posting at a locality is entitled to be reimbursed in accordance with the relevant Public Service determination for return travel by the member or a dependant to another locality in conjunction with leave as if the member were an officer of the Australian Public Service in the same circumstances as the member.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/51

Defence Act 1903

This Determination authorises assisted leave travel for members of the Australian Defence Force on long-term posting overseas and, where applicable, their dependants. This entitlement has not previously been regulated by determination.

This Determination adopts by reference the identical entitlements provided in Public Service Determination 1994/162 made under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922* for officers of the Australian Public Service (APS) serving overseas. Such adoption is authorised by subsection 58B(1A) of the *Defence Act 1903*.

The effect of this Determination is that where members and dependants undertake return leave travel from the locality of posting, their entitlements are provided as if they were APS officers or their dependants.

Clause 2 of this Determination defines certain terms used in the Determination.

Clause 3 applies the entitlements on the same basis as for APS officers.
