



OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/54

DETERMINATION UNDER THE DEFENCE ACT 1903

1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1994/54.

2. Definition

2.1 In this Determination "relevant Public Service determination" means Public Service Determination 1994/162 as in force from time to time.

3. Application

3.1 This Determination applies to a member on long-term posting who is entitled to be paid Overseas Living Allowance.

4. Vehicle Allowance and vehicle contribution

4.1 A member is entitled to be treated in accordance with the relevant Public Service determination as if the member were an officer of the Australian Public Service in the same circumstances as the member for the following:

- (a) Vehicle Allowance; and
- (b) contribution by the member for the private use of an official vehicle.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/54

Defence Act 1903

This Determination authorises the following conditions of service for members of the Australian Defence Force who are eligible for Overseas Living Allowance while on long-term posting overseas:

- . Vehicle Allowance, payable to members for use of their private motor vehicles on official business; and
- . vehicle contributions payable by members for short-term and long-term private use of official vehicles.

These entitlements were formerly set out in Determinations 3732, Overseas Vehicle Allowance, and 3733, Overseas Vehicle Contribution, which are repealed by Overseas Defence Determination 1994/55.

This Determination adopts by reference the identical entitlements provided in Public Service Determination 1994/162 made under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922* for officers of the Australian Public Service (APS) serving overseas. Such adoption is authorised by subsection 58B(1A) of the *Defence Act 1903*.

The effect of this Determination is that the specified conditions of service are provided as if members were APS officers.

Clause 2 of this Determination defines a term used in the Determination.

Clause 3 sets out the members to whom the Determination applies.

Clause 4 applies the conditions of service on the same basis as for APS officers.
