1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/60.

2. Amendment

2.1 Determination 501, Education Allowance, as amended¹, is amended as set out in this Determination.

3. Clause 24 (Conditions of payment)

3.1 Delete "a member who is divorced, widowed or permanently separated", substitute "a member without a spouse".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/60

Defence Act 1903

Determination 501, Education Allowance (the Principal Determination), provides assistance with boarding and tuition costs under certain circumstances for members of the Australian Defence Force whose children attend school away from home.

Clause 24 of the Principal Determination deals with entitlements to Education Allowance for members who would otherwise be technically ineligible because they have no spouse. As formerly worded, the clause did not apply to members who have never had a spouse.

This Determination amends the clause by substituting a generic reference to members without a spouse.
