1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1994/7.

2. Amendment

2.1 Determination 2904, Financial Benefits for Members of the Australian Defence Force Declared Redundant, as amended¹, is amended as set out in this Determination.

3. Clause 5 (Entitlement)

3.1 Paragraph 5(b):

Delete the paragraph, substitute:

"(b) been declared redundant in accordance with arrangements approved by the Minister for Defence,".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/7
Defence Act 1903

Defence Determination 2904, Financial Benefits for Members of the Australian Defence Force Declared Redundant, provides eligibility for financial benefits for members of the Australian Defence Force who are declared redundant, to compensate for the early termination of their service.

The Minister for Defence has varied the arrangements for declaration of redundancies so that his involvement in identifying individual redundancies is no longer required.

This Determination amends clause 5 of Determination 2904 to take account of these arrangements.
