1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1994/9.

2. Definition

2.1 In this Determination "relevant Public Service determination" means Public Service Board Determination 1983/15 as in force from time to time.

3. Outlay Advance

3.1 A member is entitled to be paid an Outlay Advance in accordance with the relevant Public Service determination as if the member were an officer of the Australian Public Service in the same circumstances as the member.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1994/9

Defence Act 1903

This Determination provides for Outlay Advance for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) serving on long-term posting overseas. These entitlements have not previously been regulated by determination.

This Determination adopts by reference the identical Outlay Advance entitlements provided overseas for officers of the Australian Public Service (APS) in Public Service Board Determination 1983/15 made under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*. Such adoption is authorised by subsection 58B(1A) of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Outlay Advance is provided to assist members with initial establishment costs at posts. The effect of the Determination is that Outlay Advance is provided to ADF members as if they were APS officers.
