1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Defence Determination 1995/1.

2. Commencement

2.1 This Determination is to be taken to have commenced on 4 December 1994.

3. Amendment

3.1 Determination 1907, Pet Relocation Expenses Allowance, as amended¹, is amended as set out in this Determination.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1995/1

Defence Act 1903

Determination 1907, Pet Relocation Expenses Allowance, provides for a member of the Australian Defence Force (ADF) to be reimbursed for the cost of transporting and kennelling a pet when the member has been granted a removal at Commonwealth expense.

This Determination amends Determination 1907 by increasing the maximum amount of Pet Relocation Expenses Allowance for ADF members by the same proportion and from the same date of effect as a similar increase determined for Australian Public Service staff under section 82D of the *Public Service Act 1922*.

The retrospective application of this Determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such person.
