## 1. Citation

1.1 This Determination may be cited as Overseas Defence Determination 1995/19.

## 2. Amendment

2.1 Determination 3714, Overseas Living Allowance, as amended<sup>1</sup>, is amended as set out in this Determination.

## 3. Clause 9 (Additional allowance for member living in)

### 3.1 Paragraph 9(b):

Delete the paragraph, substitute:

"(b) the sum of the costs, if any, which the member incurs for accommodation and meals."

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

**OVERSEAS DEFENCE DETERMINATION 1995/19**

*Defence Act 1903*

Determination 3714, Overseas Living Allowance (the Principal Determination) authorises payment of Overseas Living Allowance to members of the Australian Defence Force performing duty overseas.

Clause 9 of the Principal Determination provides for members living in service accommodation overseas to be paid an additional allowance equal to the cost of compulsory mess fees, accommodation and meals.

This Determination simplifies the provision specifying accommodation and meal costs by removing an obsolete reference to a set US dollar amount per day for meal costs incurred by a member in an open mess in the United States of America, and applying to such members the provision for the assessment of meal costs at all other overseas posts.
