EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Overseas Defence Determination 1997/2

Defence Act 1903

This Determination amends Overseas Defence Determination 1995/26 by changing references to “Pay Level” to “Pay Group” to reflect the current terminology used in Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal instruments authorising pay for member of the Australian Defence Force in the ‘other ranks’ category.

Overseas Defence Determination 1995/26 is also amended by inserting the rank of Second Lieutenant, with descriptive annotation, into the Schedule at Rent Group 5. This description refers to members who receive a higher rate of pay because they were enlisted before appointment as Second Lieutenant. The inclusion of this rank is consistent with the treatment of equivalent ranks in the Royal Australian Air Navy and Royal Australian Air Force, already included in the Schedule.
