EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2005/59

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2005/15, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903* (the Act). Chapter 7 of the Principal Determination sets out provisions dealing with housing assistance for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

The purpose of this Determination is to update the lists of tied and appointment homes that are reserved for occupation by members in specified positions.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 of this Determination provides that the Determination commences on the day on which it is made, as provided by subsection 58B (4) of the Act.

Clause 3 specifies that the amendment is made to the Principal Determination, as amended.

Clause 4 substitutes table item 1 in subclause 7.5.16.3 of the Principal Determination. The revised item provides that the appointment residence for Sydney is the home currently occupied by Deputy Chief Joint Operations (formerly Commander Australian Theatre). The amendment reflects the change in title of the appointment and in the house the appointment-holder occupies.

Clause 5 substitutes the table in clause 7.5.17 of the Principal Determination. The revised table provides for additional tied residences for the Chief of the Defence Force, the Vice Chief of the Defence Force and the Chief of Air Force, following renovations to the Service residences listed for those members.

The changes in clause 7.5.17 of the Principal Determination reflect the movement of the members whose positions are described into the Service residences listed for them, following a program of renovations. The changes will require a member to vacate the home when they cease to hold the position the home is tied to, to make way for a member incumbent to the position.
