EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2006/1

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2005/15, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903* (the Act). Chapter 6 and Chapter 9 of the Principal Determination set out provisions dealing, respectively, with relocations and travel in Australia for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

The purpose of this Determination is to adjust the rates of vehicle allowance and disturbance allowance in line with the Consumer Price Index to the end of the September quarter. The adjustments are based on rates published by the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations, and used extensively throughout the Australian Public Service.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 of this Determination provides that the Determination commences on 26 February 2006.

Clause 3 specifies that the amendment is made to the Principal Determination, as amended.

Clause 4 provides for an increase of 3% to disturbance allowance rates in clause 6.1.15 of the Principal Determination. This is in line with the All Groups Consumer Price Index increase for the period September 2004 to September 2005.

Clause 5 provides for an increase of 3% to the amount paid under clause 6.1.21 of the Principal Determination for each full-time student in primary or secondary school when the student must change schools because of a removal. This is in line with the All Groups Consumer Price Index increase for the period September 2004 to September 2005.

Clauses 6 and 7 provide an increase of 6.1% to vehicle allowance and additional vehicle allowance rates in clauses 9.6.24 and 9.6.25 of the Principal Determination. This is equivalent to the increase in the private motoring component of the Consumer Price Index for the period September 2004 to September 2005.
