# EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

## Defence Determination 2006/4

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2005/15, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903* (the Act). Chapter 15 of the Principal Determination deals with living and working on long-term posting overseas for members of the ADF.

The purpose of this Determination is to change benchmark schools in Singapore and Vanuatu.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 of this Determination provides that the Determination commences on the date of signature.

Clause 3 specifies that the amendment is made to the Principal Determination, as amended.

In the Principal Determination, the fees of a benchmark school are used to set the level of education assistance to which a member may be reimbursed.

Clause 4 amends Part 1 of Annex 15.6.A of the Principal Determination. This part of the Annex lists the schools which set the benchmark at the pre-school level. This clause changes the benchmark pre-school at the Vanuatu posting location to the Port Vila International School.

Clause 5 amends Part 2 of Annex 15.6.A of the Principal Determination. This part of the Annex lists the schools which set the benchmark at the primary school level. This clause changes the benchmark primary school at the Vanuatu posting location to the Port Vila International School.

Clause 6 amends Part 3 of Annex 15.6.A of the Principal Determination. This part of the Annex lists the schools which set the benchmark at the secondary school level. This clause changes the benchmark secondary school at the Singapore posting location to the Australian International School Singapore.
