1 Citation

Example 1: A member who is deployed to a location with a medium threat level in relation to military, armed or related threat and environmental hazard is entitled to a daily rate of deployment allowance of AUD 61.30. That daily rate is made up of:

- AUD 40.70 in relation to the military, armed or related threat, and
- AUD 20.60 in relation to the environmental hazard.

Example 2: A member who is deployed to a location with a medium military, armed or related threat level and very high environmental hazard is entitled to a daily rate of deployment allowance of AUD 78.40. That daily rate is made up of:

- AUD 40.70 in relation to the military, armed or related threat, and
- AUD 37.70 in relation to the environmental hazard.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Determination 2006/7

This Determination amends Defence Determination 2005/15, Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903* (the Act). Chapter 17 of the Principal Determination sets out provisions dealing with warlike and non-warlike deployments for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

The purpose of this Determination is to increase rates of deployment allowance.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 of this Determination provides that the Determination commences on 9 March 2006.

Clause 3 specifies that the amendment is made to the Principal Determination, as amended.

Clause 4 amends a table in subclause 17.9.8.1 of the Principal Determination. The rates of deployment allowance set out in this table have been increased by 1.5% to align with an adjustment to the salaries of ADF members under the *ADF Workplace Remuneration Arrangement 2004-2006*.

Clause 5 amends two examples in subclause 17.9.8.1 of the Principal Determination. The figures in the examples have been updated to reflect the rate increases set out in clause 4 of this Determination.
