

DEFENCE FORCE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

DETERMINATION NO. 9 of 1987

Pursuant to section 58H of the Defence Act 1903, the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal, having inquired into the extension of Sea-going Allowance and Hard Lying Allowance to qualified submariners, hereby determines as follows:

1. Determination 0203, Sea-going Allowance, being a determination made by the Minister for Defence under section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 and varied by determinations of the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal, is amended by inserting in sub-paragraph 10(c)(ii) ", other than a member who is entitled to an allowance under paragraph 3(c), 3(d), 3(e) or clause 4 or 5 of that Determination" after "Allowance".
2. Determination 0205, Hard Lying Allowance, being a determination made by the Minister for Defence under section 58B of the Defence Act 1903 and varied by determinations of the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal, is amended by inserting in sub-paragraph 5(c)(iii) ", other than a member who is entitled to an allowance under paragraph 3(c), 3(d), 3(e) or clause 4 or 5 of that Determination" after "Allowance".
3. This determination shall take effect on and from 9 December 1987.
