DETERMINATION NO 19 OF 1995

Senior Officer Allowance

Pursuant to Section 58H of the Defence Act 1903, the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal hereby determines as follows:


1. Determination No 6 of 1995, Senior Officer Allowance, being a determination made by the Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal pursuant to Section 58H of the Defence Act 1903, is amended by:

- a. deleting the rate "1071" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 opposite the entry for Lieutenant Colonel and substituting the rate "1092";
- b. deleting the rate "1605" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 opposite the entry for Colonel and substituting the rate "1636";
- c. deleting the rate "2.93" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 2 opposite the entry for Lieutenant Colonel and substituting the rate "2.99";
- d. deleting the rate "4.40" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 2 opposite the entry for Colonel and substituting the rate "4.48";
- e. deleting the rate "401" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 3 opposite the entry for Consultant Colonel (Medical), Active Australian Army Reserve, 2nd Military District, and substituting the rate "409";
- f. deleting the rate "401" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 3 opposite the entry for Consultant Colonel (Medical), Active Australian Army Reserve, 3rd Military District, and substituting the rate "409";
- g. deleting the rate "401" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 3 opposite the entry for Colonel Medical, 1st Division, and substituting the rate "409"; and
- h. deleting the rate "268" specified in Column 2 of Schedule 3 opposite the entry for Chaplain Division 4B and substituting the rate "273".

2. This determination shall take effect on and from 6 April 1995 to 28 June 1995 (inclusive).


