



Determination under the *Defence Employees Certified Agreement 2004-2006*

No. 19 of 2004, Travel for representational purposes

I, CHRISTON SCOTT CHAMLEY, acting in accordance with the delegation of powers to me under clause J4 of the *Defence Employees Certified Agreement 2004-2006* (DECA) by the Secretary to the Department of Defence:

1. Having regard to the circumstances in which employees perform short-term duty overseas, have reviewed the conditions of service for employees performing that duty.
2. Hereby determine under clause I12 of the DECA that the conditions of service for employees performing short-term duty overseas are to be adjusted as follows:
 - a. the conditions relating to approval of spouse-accompanied travel for representational purposes, and the entitlements where approval is granted, are to be in accordance with clause 14.4.1 of the Australian Defence Organisation Pay and Conditions Manual, Overseas Conditions of Service Volume, as amended by Defence Determination 2004/38 made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*; and
 - b. for the purpose of applying the conditions in the Australian Defence Organisation Pay and Conditions Manual, Overseas Conditions of Service Volume, the terms in the following table that apply to ADF members are to be taken to include the corresponding terms in the table that apply to APS employees, except where there is an express contrary intention:

	ADF term	Corresponding APS term
1.	member	employee
2.	Brigadier or higher	Senior Executive Service (SES) employee
3.	Chief of the Defence Force (CDF)	Secretary
4.	additional duty	overtime
5.	higher duties allowance	additional responsibility pay
6.	recreation leave	annual leave
7.	rank	classification
8.	ADF	APS
