



**Determination under the Defence Employees Certified Agreement 2004-2006  
No. 29 of 2005, Overseas conditions of service – household help**

**1. Authority**

I, Brian Gary Paule, acting in accordance with the delegation of powers to me under clause J4 of the Defence Employees Certified Agreement 2004-2006 (DECA) by the Secretary to the Department of Defence, hereby determine under clause I12 of the DECA that the conditions of service for employees travelling and working overseas on long-term postings are to be adjusted as set out below.

**2. Definitions**

For the purpose of applying the conditions in the Australian Defence Organisation Pay and Conditions Manual, Overseas Conditions of Service Volume, the terms in the following table that apply to ADF members are to be taken to include the corresponding terms in the table that apply to APS employees, except where there is an express contrary intention (such as supporting a specified ADF operation):

	<b>ADF term</b>	<b>Corresponding APS term</b>
1.	member	employee
2.	Brigadier or higher	Senior Executive Service (SES) employee
3.	Chief of the Defence Forces (CDF)	Secretary
4.	additional duty	overtime
5.	recreation leave	annual leave
6.	rank	classification
7.	ADF	APS

**3. Determination of conditions**

I determine that the conditions of service applicable to overseas locations are to be varied in accordance with the attached copy of Defence Determination 2005/55, Overseas conditions of service – household help, as published in Chapter 15 of the Australian Defence Organisation Pay and Conditions Manual, Overseas Conditions of Service Volume.

**4. Commencement**

This adjustment is effective from 15 December 2005.
