DETERMINATION NO. 25 OF 2001

SPECIALIST OPERATIONS INTERIM TRAINING ALLOWANCE

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Commencement

1. This Determination commences on 20 December 2001 and will operate until a further determination is made by the Tribunal or 30 June 2002 which ever occurs first.

Entitlement to allowance

2. A qualified commando or qualified clearance diver undertaking counter-terrorist training is entitled to specialist operations interim training allowance at the rate of \$9,760 a year for the duration of the training.

Allowances not payable

3. A member who is entitled to specialist operations interim training allowance is not entitled to any of the following allowances:

- (a) clearance diving allowance (disability);
- (b) diving allowance;
- (c) field allowance;
- (d) flight duties allowance;
- (e) flying allowance (disability);
- (f) hard lying allowance;
- (g) paratrooper allowance;
- (h) seagoing allowance;
- (i) special action forces allowance;
- (j) submarine service allowance (disability);
- (k) unpredictable explosives allowance.
