DETERMINATION NO. 2 OF 2002

FIELD ALLOWANCE - AMENDMENT

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*:

Commencement

1. This Determination commences on 14 March 2002

Amendment

2. Determination No. 14 of 1995, Field Allowance, as amended, is amended as set out in this Determination.

Clause 3 (Application)

- 3.1 Omit "Tier 1 - \$30.07 per day", substitute "Tier 1 - \$36.08 a day".
- 3.2 Omit "Tier 2 - \$17.64 per day", substitute "Tier 2 - \$21.17 a day".

Clause 4 (Application)

- 4.1 Renumber the clause as subclause 4.1.
- 4.2 Add at the end:
 - 4.2 In spite of the criteria mentioned in clause 3 for payment of Field Allowance at the Tier 1 rate, the Chief of the Defence Force may in special circumstances approve the Tier 1 rate for a prolonged period of field service for which Field Allowance is payable.
- 4.3 For the purpose of subclause 4.2, the Chief of the Defence Force must have regard to:
 - (a) the duration of the period of field service; and
 - (b) whether the Tier 2 rate of field allowance would adequately compensate members for the hardships of the period of field service, in all the circumstances of the case.
