1 Citation

This Determination may be cited as Public Service (Defence) Determination 2000/3, Overseas Conditions of Service (Public Service (Defence) Determination 1999/11 – Amendment).

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 20 January 2000.

3 Amendment

Public Service (Defence) Determination 1999/11, Overseas Conditions of Service, as amended,¹ is amended as set out in this Determination.

4 Schedule 6 (Overseas living allowance)

Omit the Schedule, substitute the Schedule set out in Attachment A to this Determination.

5 Schedule 7 (Supplementary allowances)

Omit the Schedule, substitute the Schedule set out in Attachment B to this Determination.

6 Transitional

(1) In this clause:

former amount of OLA, for an employee, means the amount of OLA to which the employee was entitled for the relevant period.

OLA means Overseas Living Allowance.

Principal Determination means Public Service (Defence) Determination 1999/11, Overseas Conditions of Service, as amended.

relevant period means the period beginning on 2 September 1999 and ending immediately before this Determination commences.

revised amount of OLA, for an employee, means the amount of OLA to which the employee would have been entitled for the relevant period if Schedules 6 and 7 to the Principal Determination had included the respective entries set out in Attachments A and B with effect from 2 September 1999.

(2) If, in relation to the relevant period, an employee's revised amount of OLA exceeds the employee's former amount of OLA, the employee is entitled to additional OLA equal to the amount of the excess.

(3) For this clause, so much of the Principal Determination as relates to payment of OLA under Part 6 of Chapter 4 and Schedules 6 and 7 of that Determination (as varied by this Determination) is to be treated as having come into operation immediately before 2 September 1999.

Explanatory statement

Public Service (Defence) Determination 2000/3

This Determination amends Public Service (Defence) Determination 1999/11, Overseas Conditions of Service (the Principal Determination), to implement a worldwide review of overseas living allowance (OLA) for localities at which Australian Public Service employees of the Department of Defence are serving on long-term posting overseas. The revised rates of OLA take account of variations in prices and exchange rate movements at the localities.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 provides for this Determination to commence on payday 20 January 2000.

Clause 3 specifies that the amendments are made to the Principal Determination.

Clauses 4 and 5 omit the Schedules setting out rates of OLA and supplementary allowances respectively, and substitute revised Schedules.

Clause 6 sets out a transitional provision which authorises payment to an eligible employee of additional OLA equal to the amount (if any) by which the OLA paid during the period affected by this clause falls short of the OLA to which the employee would have been entitled if this Determination had applied during the period. The clause operates as follows:

- subclause (1) defines certain expressions used in the clause;
- subclause (2) sets out the transitional effect from payday 2 September 1999, the date of currency for the worldwide OLA review data; and
- subclause (3) allows the transitional provision to operate in relation to a period earlier than the commencement of the Principal Determination on 8 December 1999.
