## **1 Citation**

## **2 Commencement**

This Determination commences on 31 January 2002.

## **3 Amendment**

Public Service (Defence) Determination 1999/11, Overseas Conditions of Service, as amended,<sup>1</sup> is amended as set out in this Determination.

## **4 Subparagraphs 4.6.12 (3) (a) and 4.6.12 (3) (b) (Rate of post adjustment)**

*substitute*

- (a) for each dependant who is under 10 years — AUD 188; and
- (b) for the employee and any other dependant — AUD 376.

## **5 Schedule 6 (Overseas living allowance)**

## **6 Schedule 7 (Supplementary allowances)**

*substitute*

the Schedule set out in Attachment B.

## **7 Transitional**

- (1) If Schedules 6 and 7, as substituted by this Determination, had applied for the period between 13 September 2001 and 30 January 2002 and would have resulted in an employee's entitlement to overseas living allowance exceeding the amount of overseas living allowance previously paid for that period, the employee is entitled to additional overseas living allowance equal to the amount of the excess.
- (2) For all other employees, the amount of entitlement for the period 13 September 2001 to 30 January 2002 is not affected by this Determination.

# EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

## Public Service (Defence) Determination 2002/1

This Determination amends Public Service (Defence) Determination 1999/11, Overseas conditions of service (the Principal Determination), made under subsection 24 (1) of the *Public Service Act 1999*, to implement a review of overseas living allowance (OLA) for localities at which Australian Public Service employees of the Department of Defence are on long-term posting overseas. The revised OLA rates take account of movements in applicable exchange rates and the results of a pricing survey of goods and services.

Defence Determination 2000/1, Conditions of Service, made under section 58B of the *Defence Act 1903*, applies the provisions of the Principal Determination to members of the Australian Defence Force as if the members were employees in the same circumstances.

The revised OLA rates for Tuvalu have not been included in this Determination pending advice on revised data for that locality.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 provides for this Determination to commence on 31 January 2002.

Clause 3 specifies that the amendments are made to the Principal Determination, as amended.

Clause 4 amends the rate of supplementary post adjustment for long-term posting in Tonga. The revised amounts are due to exchange rate movement since the last review of the adult and child ferry rates to Fafa Island. The minimum age of an adult fare is amended to 10 years of age. This reflects a change in the ferry ticket rates.

Clauses 5 and 6 substitute revised Schedules setting out rates of OLA and supplementary allowances respectively.

Clause 7 sets out the transitional effect from payday 13 September 2001, the common date of validity for the basic survey information of price variations for the overseas posts. The amount payable to employees will only be revised for those who would be entitled to an increase.
