1 Citation

This Determination is Public Service (Defence) Determination 2003/3, Vehicle allowance.

2 Commencement

This Determination commences on 26 February 2004.

3 Purpose

The purpose of this Determination is to revise vehicle allowance rates for employees of the Department of Defence.

4 Vehicle allowance

The following table revises the vehicle allowance rates provided in clause 563 of the *Defence Employees Certified Agreement 2004 – 2006*.

Component	Rate per kilometre
Engine capacity above 2,600 cc or rotary engine capacity above 1,300cc	62 cents
Engine capacity between 1,601 and 2,600 cc or rotary engine capacity between 801 cc and 1,300 cc	61 cents
Engine capacity of 1,600 cc or less or rotary engine capacity 800 cc or less	51 cents
Additional amount for transportation of one or more passengers, transportation of Departmental equipment, tools or materials weighing not less than 100 kilograms, or towing a Departmental trailer	0.70 of a cent

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Public Service (Defence) Determination 2004/3

This Determination revises vehicle allowance rates provided by the *Defence Employees Certified Agreement 2004 – 2006* (DECA) for employees of the Department of Defence.

The purpose of this Determination is to increase the rates of vehicle allowance by 1% which is equivalent to the increase in the private motoring component of the Consumer Price Index of the period September 2002 to September 2003.

Clause 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Clause 2 provides for this Determination to commence on 26 February 2004.

Clause 3 of this Determination explains that the purpose of this Determinations is to revise vehicle allowance rates payable to employees of the Department of Defence.

Clause 4 of this Determination revises to vehicle allowance rates provided in the DECA. The 1% increase in the allowance is equivalent to the increase in the private motoring component of the Consumer Price Index of the period September 2002 to September 2003.
