

Garden Island (East) Critical Infrastructure Recovery Program: Works to commence soon

Garden Island Defence Precinct, Sydney, New South Wales

The Department of Defence previously advised you that it was seeking approval to deliver critical infrastructure and engineering works in two stages under the Garden Island (East) Critical Infrastructure Recovery Program. Defence has now obtained Parliamentary Approval to commence the construction of the works under both stages.



The works include demolishing two existing wharves at the northern end of the island and rebuilding them in a revised alignment (Stage One), as well as remediating the remaining wharves and base-wide engineering services across the island (Stage Two).

Construction is expected to commence in September 2018 for completion in February 2022 (Stage One) and September 2023 (Stage Two).
