Description

Humpty Doo Transmitting Station is situated on an almost 800 hectare parcel of land near Middle Point and is located approximately 50 kilometres east/ south east of Darwin.

The Royal Australian Navy opened the transmitting station in 1982 to replace a facility at Coonawarra East that was destroyed by Cyclone Tracy in 1974. The station supports the Darwin naval base HMAS Coonawarra.



Base Activities

The only activity identified on the property that relates to potential site contamination is the use of underground storage tanks (USTs) and above ground storage tanks (ASTs) for diesel and waste oil storage. A total of six USTs and one AST have been installed at the property.

Contamination Information

Known Contamination

There are no known contamination issues at the property.

Risk Assessment

No significant risks to human health and the environment are identified on the property or on surrounding land based on investigations completed to date.

Current Status

A Stage 1 desktop investigation and environmental investigation of ASTs/USTs has been completed for the property.

Defence will conduct further investigations as required.
