Direction on Specific Content

Executive Summary

Introduction

Include a précis of:

- The preceding steps to arriving at this point.
- The major factors arising out of Site and Issues analyses.
- What influenced or determined zone and precinct boundaries.
- The general functions of the base or establishment – existing or future planned. Population estimates etc.
- The operational requirements that currently exist.
- The changes to capability planned for in the future.

Note that more background information supporting the formulation of the Zone Plan can be found in the appendices.

Define zones, precincts and special provisions.

For instance - zones essentially delineate areas of land within which activities of a compatible nature can occur.
