COMMITTEE DECISION 194/03

**Subject: Policy – Training Days Allocation to Undertake Legal Training Module
Subject Examination/Paper**

The Committee noted:

1. The written request to LTCOL McConaghy, A/DMLC, claiming training days for Reserve legal officers to undertake Legal Training Module (LTM) subject examinations/papers.
2. The DFRT Decision on the Legal Officers' Specialist Career Structure WEF 16 Mar 00 and the requirement to complete LTM subjects to be eligible to advance.
3. That, subject to funding restrictions, it is reasonable to permit Reserve legal officers undertaking LTM subject examinations/papers to be granted training days to undertake those examinations/papers.

The Committee decided to:

1. **Agree** that, subject to training days being available, Reserve legal officers undertaking LTM subject examinations/papers may claim a **maximum** of three (3) days per subject.
2. **Agree** that LTM 1 is regarded as one subject for the purposes of claiming training days.
