**COMMITTEE DECISION 78/01**

**Subject: Policy – Naming of Training Courses**

**The Committee noted:**

1. The DFRT Decision on the Legal Officers' Career Structure WEF 16 Mar 00 and, in particular, the references to competency levels for legal officers.
2. That the Committee in its decisions since that time have been using the term "legal competency level (LL)" and designating those levels, namely LL1, LL2, LL3, LL4 and LL5.
2. That the Military Law Centre, in developing the training courses for legal officers commenced using the same abbreviations when referring to training courses that were requirements for legal officers to progress to the next legal competency level, however, the numbering system was not the same as for the legal competency levels and this has caused confusion.

**The Committee decided:**

1. To **agree** that henceforth the training courses shall be titled Legal Training Modules (LTM).
