



DFRDB Re-Entry

From 1 July 2016

DFRDB pension recipient decides to re-enter.

You **must** join the *ADF superannuation arrangement*.
You will still receive your DFRDB pension.
You will also have access to *ADF Cover* until age 60.

Note: Those members who **'must'** join the *ADF superannuation arrangement* still have choice over which accumulation fund they elect for employer contributions

MSBS Re-Entry

From 1 July 2016

MSBS member deciding to re-enter

If you have a preserved employer benefit

you must rejoin MSBS.
Rejoining MSBS members must complete web form AE689 to ensure they are enrolled into the correct fund and to advise their pay area if they have a preserved MSBS employer benefit.

If you've taken a pension

you must join the *ADF superannuation arrangement*.
You will still receive your MSBS pension.

If you've taken a lump sum

you must join the *ADF superannuation arrangement*.

Note: – Continuing MSBS members may move to the *ADF superannuation arrangement* from 1 July 2016 if they wish.
– Those members who **'must'** join the *ADF superannuation arrangement* still have a choice over which accumulation fund they elect for employer contributions.
