You should be aware that if the goods are to be re-exported, even after remanufacture or incorporation into another item, you may require an export permit or licence from the Australian Government.

A person making a false representation, in any manner whatsoever, may be prosecuted for an offence against the Crimes Act 1914 and, if convicted, face a maximum penalty of a fine of \$60 000 for a corporation or a fine of \$12 000 for an individual, and/or imprisonment for 2 years.
