This is the Director and the deckhead of the Bridge. Perryman said "The distinctive bridge deck head (roof) lying against the front of the Director Control Tower." In fact it is plainly not lying against it, they are firmly attached to each other. The deckhead is not lying against the 'front' of the Director but against its bottom. The Director itself is almost upside down, facing into the seabed. The point is, Sydney's deckhead was attached to the front of the Bridge not to the Director, and formed part of the Bridge itself. The Director stood on its own supporting pedestal and was separate from the deckhead. This however is typical of another type of ship completely.
