

STATEMENT BY DAVID BURROWS

Mr. Burrows stated that a friend (Edgar Biddle) found a Grave Cross with Japanese characters on it, back from the beach, north of Horrocks Beach in early 1941, so he and a friend dug it up to have a look. They found a cache of guns, amunition and charts of the W.A. Coast showing breaks in the reef etc.
