Dear Professor Kawano,

Thank you very much for your kind fax of August 21, which has been most helpful. I hesitate to impose further on your kindness and generosity but wonder if I might make one or two small additional queries.

1. Would it be possible to obtain details of any patrols by *I-60* and *I-59* in November 1941, including place and date of departure/return?
2. Would it be possible to obtain details of any patrols by *I-121*, *I-122*, *I-123* and *I-124* in November 1941, including place and date of departure/return?
3. Would it be possible to obtain similar details for *I-62*, *I-64*, *I-65* and *I-66* in November 1941?
4. Is it known on which day the Third Submarine Group – *I-8*, *I-68*, *I-69*, *I-70*, *I-71*, *I-72*, *I-73*, *I-74* and *I-75* – left the Inland Sea for Hawaii via Kwajalein in the Marshall Islands in November 1941? My guess is about November 15.
5. Am I correct in assuming that the Second Submarine Group – *I-1*, *I-2*, *I-3*, *I-4*, *I-5*, *I-6* and *I-7* – set out for Hawaii from Yokosuka on November 16??
6. Did the First Submarine Group – *I-9*, *I-15*, *I-17* and *I-25* – also leave from Yokosuka on November 21?

Thanking you for any assistance you might be able to provide on these matters.
