CAPABILITY STATEMENT

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is a Capability Statement?

A Capability Statement outlines an individual or company's services, experience, licences and qualifications. Its purpose is to clearly and effectively communicate your individual or business capabilities to Defence.

2. Why do I need to submit a Capability Statement?

Individuals and businesses interested in participating in works at the new training area near Greenvale in North Queensland are invited to submit their business skills and describe their capabilities in the format of a Capability Statement.

Submitting a Capability Statement helps Defence gather accurate information about the local workforce and establishes a pool of interested individuals and businesses.

Defence, medium works contractors and the Managing Contractor will use the Capability Statements to maximise the participation of local businesses when compiling and implementing works packages.

3. Who is eligible to submit a Capability Statement?

Defence encourages Greenvale residents, Traditional Owners and other parties interested in early works to submit a Capability Statement.

4. How do I submit my Capability Statement?

Visit www.defence.gov.au/Initiatives/ASMTI to download and complete the Capability Statement template.

5. Why do I need to submit my Capability Statement to Aurecon Group?

Aurecon Group is the Project Manager and Contract Administrator (PMCA) for the ASMTI.

Aurecon Group is collating Capability Statements for the new training area near Greenvale. These Capability Statements will be provided to Defence, medium works contractors and the Managing Contractor once these contractors are appointed.

The information received by the Commonwealth upon submission of the Capability Statements will only be used in relation to the ASMTI Facilities Project near Greenvale.

6. How do I know if my Capability Statement has been received?

If your Capability Statement has been successfully submitted, you will receive an automatic email acknowledging receipt from ASMTI.GVTA.CapStat@aurecongroup.com

7. When is my Capability Statement due?

Capability Statements are requested to be submitted no later than **12 noon AEST 31 December 2022** for both the early and main works.

8. Does completing a Capability Statement mean I will get work under the ASMTI?

Submitting a Capability Statement does not guarantee work. Capability Statements provide individuals and businesses with an opportunity to communicate their skills and capabilities to Defence and are used to gather information that enables Defence to understand the capacity of the local workforce.

To be considered for works packages under the ASMTI, businesses will still be required to respond to tenders or expressions of interest for early work packages being released by Defence from July 2019.

9. Will I be contacted if my capabilities and skills are required for the ASMTI?

Individuals and businesses with skills and capabilities required by Defence will be contacted on an as required basis or in support of future procurement activities.

10. I plan to tender for the works. Do I still need to complete a Capability Statement?

No. Submitting a Capability Statement helps Defence gather accurate information about the local workforce, but is not a requirement for tendering for work packages.

To be eligible for work under the ASMTI, businesses need to respond to tenders or expressions of interest for early work packages.

11. I plan to tender for work packages for the training area near Greenvale. When will the first packages be released?

Early works packages for the new training area near Greenvale will be progressively released from mid-July 2019 to 2022.

Defence will continue to inform local businesses of these opportunities as they become available.

12. I do not live in Greenvale. Can I submit a Capability Statement?

Defence is aiming to support local industry participation in the development of the training area. Individuals and businesses living and working in close proximity to Greenvale are invited to submit a Capability Statement and will be assessed for their capacity to deliver

works for the ASMTI. Those living in other towns and regions are also welcome to submit a Capability Statement.

13. How will Defence protect my information?

The information received by the Commonwealth upon submission of the Capability Statements will only be used in relation to the ASMTI Facilities Project near Greenvale.

14. Can I withdraw or amend my Capability Statement if my circumstances or capabilities change?
