Dear Sir,

I request that you shelve the proposed Cruise Ship Access to Fleet Base East. The principal reason for my request is that the proposed area has already reached saturated development. I submit the following points to support my request:

AIR POLLUTION

The local area has more than its share of air pollution, primarily from motor vehicles and Naval vessels docked in Fleet Base East.

NOISE

This area is subjected to very high noise levels from motor vehicles and plant -

generated noise from docked Naval vessels as well as from loud speaker systems on vessels.

CAR PARKING

Car parking in this area is already at a premium. There is simply no extra room for additional car parking.

CONGESTION

The areas immediately adjacent to the proposal are very high ^{density} residential areas. Any further development would make present congestion overwhelming.

I trust you will consider the above issues in your deliberations, and shelve the proposal and give the long-suffering residents a break.
