Vision

E&IG will implement GEMS to provide a single integrated system for managing the estate and base services.

Context

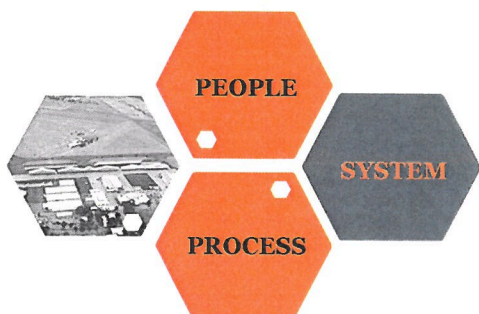
The GEMS project was established to provide E&IG with a comprehensive information management solution to support the Defence Estate Lifecycle.

GEMS will provide a unified and authoritative source of data on estate assets, commercial transactions, maintenance management plans and estate geospatial information.

E&IG will continue to simplify organisational structures and business processes related to estate planning, development, delivery, management, sustainment and disposal and ensure alignment with the One Defence business model and revised end-to-end Capability Life Cycle.

GEMS will provide the Defence Estate information and data footprint for integration into the emerging Defence Enterprise Resourcing Planning (ERP) system.

The Estate footprint is seen as a foundational element of the ERP, noting the role of E&IG as a key enabler in delivering broader Defence capability.



Objectives

Objective 1: Single source of truth

GEMS will be the single, authoritative source of estate information.

Objective 2: All reporting from GEMS

All estate reporting to the E&IG Executive will come from GEMS.

Objective 3: People, Process and System alignment

The Business Transformation activity will ensure the alignment of people, processes and the estate management system within E&IG.

Objective 4: Data will be complete and accurate

The business will ensure that all data entered into GEMS is both complete and accurate.

Implementation Framework

This policy will be delivered through a comprehensive Business Transformation Strategy and associated Action Plans.

The Policy, the Transformation Strategy and Action Plans will be reviewed regularly to ensure current legislation, operations, practices and technologies are reflected.
