**OUT-OF-SESSION DECISION OF 28 NOV 13
COMMITTEE DECISION 65/13**

Subject: Policy – Approved LTM3 Elective Subjects for 2014


The Committee noted:

1. The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal (DFRT) Decisions on the Legal Officers' Specialist Officer Career Structure (LOSOCS), the LOSOCS Policy and previous LO CPDC Policy Decisions 73/07, 131/07, 23/09, 91/09 and 32/10.
2. That the tender process for the delivery of Legal Education Services for Defence Legal resulted in a contract the Australian National University (ANU) and the University of Adelaide as a consortium.
3. That the new contract warranted inclusion of a number of subjects offered by the University of Adelaide and the Military Law Centre (MLC) decided to undertake a complete review of elective subjects approved for Legal Training Module (LTM) 3.
4. That in a brief dated 15 Nov 13, the DMLC made recommendations concerning approval of:
 - a. subjects from the ANU College of Law electives and highlighted in green in Attachment A;
 - b. subjects previously approved as Leadership and Management electives, namely MGMT6059 – Leadership Skills, MGMT7030 – Management and Organisations, and POGO8111 – Public Sector Leadership;
 - c. subjects from the University of Adelaide electives and highlighted in green in Attachment C; and
 - d. strategic study electives from the ANU College of Asia & the Pacific highlighted in green in Attachment D.
5. That the DMLC also noted that students may make an application through the MLC to the Committee for approval of a subject not listed above.
6. That members of the Committee have agreed to the recommendations made by DMLC.

The Committee decided to:

1. **Approve as suitable as elective subjects for LTM3 in 2014:**
 - a. subjects from the ANU College of Law electives highlighted in green in Attachment A;
 - b. subjects previously approved as Leadership and Management electives, namely MGMT6059 – Leadership Skills, MGMT7030 – Management and Organisations, and POGO8111 – Public Sector Leadership;
 - c. subjects from the University of Adelaide electives highlighted in green in Attachment C; and
 - d. strategic study subjects from the ANU College of Asia & the Pacific electives highlighted in green in Attachment D.

2. **Note** that students may make an application through the MLC to the Committee for approval of a subject not listed above.
