COMMITTEE DECISION 20/07**

**Subject: Policy – Completion of Legal Training Module Subjects**

**The Committee noted:**

1. The DFRT Decisions on the Legal Officers' Specialist Officer Career Structure (LOSOCS) WEF 16 Mar 00 and 1 Jul 04 and the LOSCS Outline dated 1 Dec 05.
2. That the Committee recognised that legal officers will not be advanced to a higher CL until they have satisfactorily completed Legal Training Module (LTM) subjects, however, there were different opinions as to the date that should be recognized.
3. That DMLC confirmed that once a legal officer had submitted a paper or examination to the University for marking the legal officer had completed all that was required to satisfy the academic requirements for completion of that subject.

**The Committee decided to:**

1. **Agree** that for the purposes of advancement in CL a Legal Officer will have completed a LTM subject on the day that the Legal Officer submits the completed final examination or paper for that subject, provided that examination or paper results in a pass in that subject.
