Subject: Use of permanent LOs as Prosecuting Officers

The Committee noted:

1. DDL's oral status report on this subject, which indicated that, since the inception of the program in early Jun 00, relatively few permanent LOs had been used as prosecuting officers before Service tribunals.

The Committee decided that:

1. Whenever a requirement arises for a prosecuting officer and the unit or base concerned determines that it will not be able to make a permanent LO available, DDL is to be informed without delay and is in turn to advise all other permanent LOs of the requirement and invite expressions of interest from them, before considering use of Reserve LOs.
