It is notified for general information that the Governor-General has made the following Determinations regarding the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975.

AUSTRALIAN ACTIVE SERVICE MEDAL 1945-1975 REGULATIONS

DECLARATION UNDER REGULATION 3

DETERMINATION UNDER SUBREGULATION 4(2)

- I, WILLIAM PATRICK DEANE, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting under the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 Regulations set out in the Schedule to Letters Patent dated 11 December 1997 ("the Regulations"), and on the recommendation of the Minister for Defence Industry, Science and Personnel:
- (a) declare, under regulation 3 of the Regulations, Defence Force activities in Korea during the period that commenced on 1 July 1950 and ended on 27 July 1953 to be a prescribed operation for the purposes of the Regulations; and
- (b) determine, under subregulation 4(2) of the Regulations, that the conditions for award of the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'KOREA' in respect of that prescribed operation are:
 - (i) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, as a member of the Defence Force, qualified for the Korea Medal in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Command Paper 8314 dated July 1951; and

(ii) the Medal may be awarded to a person who, in accordance with a determination made by the Minister under paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, is in a class of persons who may be awarded the Medal with clasp 'KOREA'.

DETERMINATION UNDER PARAGRAPH 4(1)(b)

I, BRONWYN BISHOP, Minister for Defence Industry, Science and Personnel, acting under the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 Regulations set out in the Schedule to Letters Patent dated 11 December 1997 ("the Regulations"), make the following determination.

Classes of persons who may be awarded the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'KOREA'

For the purposes of paragraph 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, I determine the persons described below to be a class of persons who may be awarded the Australian Active Service Medal 1945-1975 with clasp 'KOREA':

(a) Australian civilians who qualified for the Korea Medal in accordance with the conditions for that award set out in Command Paper 8314 dated July 1951.
