



## Countries with Security of Information Agreements and Arrangements (SIA) with Defence

A Security of Information Agreement or Arrangement (SIA) is a formal commitment to apply reciprocal protection to official information exchanged between the parties. This protection is to agreed security standards outlined in the relevant SIA.

The existence of an SIA does not provide blanket approval for the release of classified information.

Approval must be granted by an appropriate releasing authority on every occasion, where there is a need to release official information.
