REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL



- **Requires submission of a price and non-price proposal**
- **Public bid opening will not be held**
- **Intent is to award without discussions**
- **However if discussions are deemed necessary, discussions will be held with those Offerors within the competitive range**
- **Award based upon best value to the Government based upon price and technical (non-price) evaluation**
- **Projects may be either Design-Build or Design-Bid-Build**

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL CONTINUED



TRADEOFF SOURCE SELECTION PROCESS

–The non-price evaluation factors, when combined, may be considered

- Significantly more important than price;
- Approximately equal to price; OR
- Significantly less important than price

–Tradeoffs permitted

–Award may be made to other than the lowest priced proposal or other than the highest ranked non-price proposal

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL CONTINUED



• LOWEST PRICE TECHNICALLY ACCEPTABLE (LPTA)

– Award to lowest evaluated price of proposals meeting or exceeding the acceptability standards for technical factors

- Comparative assessment of proposals does not apply
- Tradeoffs not permitted
- All technical factors and sub factors are of equal weight

CONTRACT METHODS FOR PROCURING MILCON PROJECTS



DESIGN-BID-BUILD vs. DESIGN-BUILD

• Design-Bid-Build (DBB):

–Involves Two Separate Contract Actions:

- A-E contract awarded for preparation of full plans and specification (Design)
- Construction contract awarded based upon full plans and specifications

• Design-Build (DB):

–Design-Build means combining design and construction in a single contract with one contractor

–Government provides concept and/or 30% design as part of Phase 2 amendment

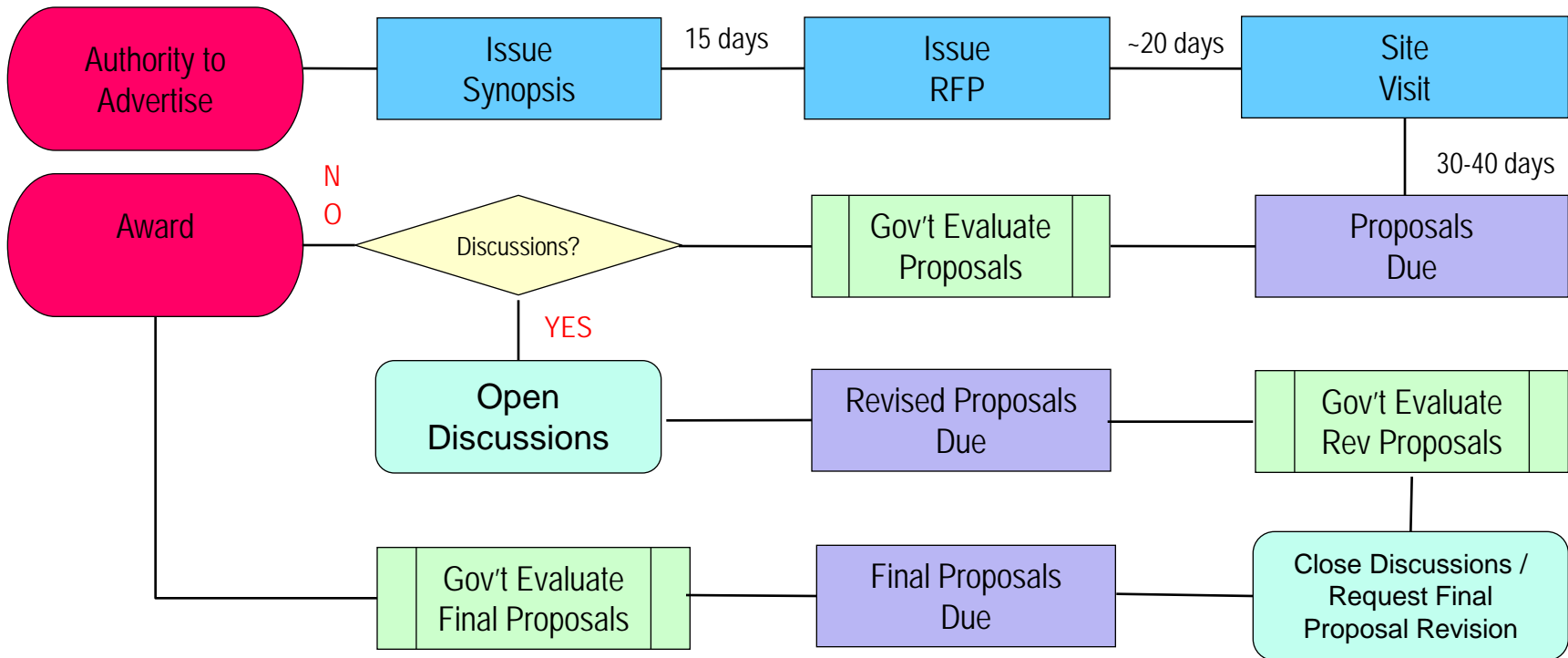
–The RFP Requirements tell the Contractor WHAT we want, not HOW to accomplish the project

–FAR 36.3 requires use of two phase source selection

SINGLE PHASE (DESIGN-BID-BUILD)



This Process is to Award the Construction Contract Only



Process takes approximately 150 days from Proposal Receipt to Contract Award

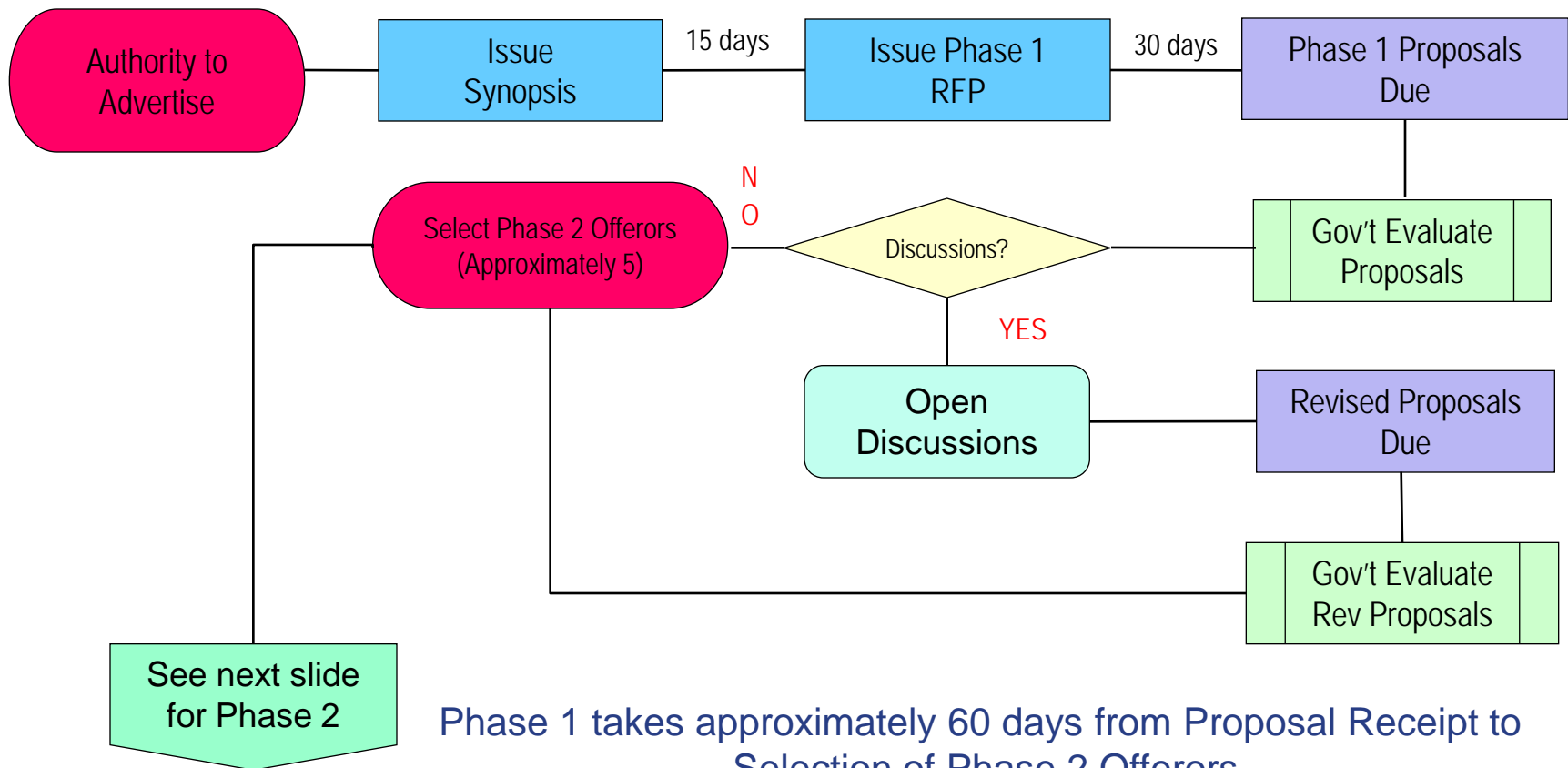

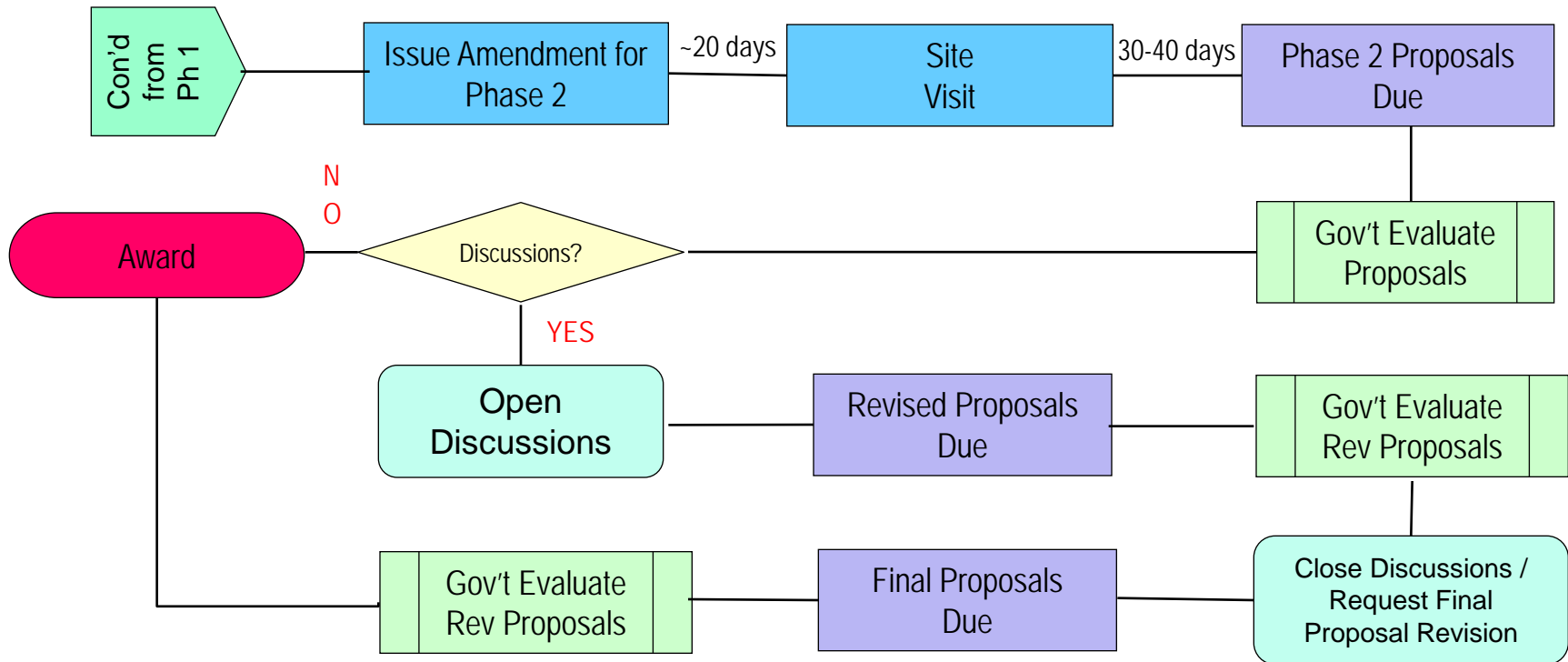

DESIGN-BUILD REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) EXAMPLE



• TWO-PHASE DESIGN-BUILD EVALUATION FACTORS

–Phase One:

- Non-price Evaluation Factors: (1) Technical Approach; (2) Experience; and (3) Past Performance
- Price is NOT evaluated in Phase-One
- Select most highly qualified offerors to participate in Phase-Two (not-to-exceed 5)

–Phase Two:

- Non-price Evaluation Factors: (4) Safety; (5) Energy Design Reduction
- Price

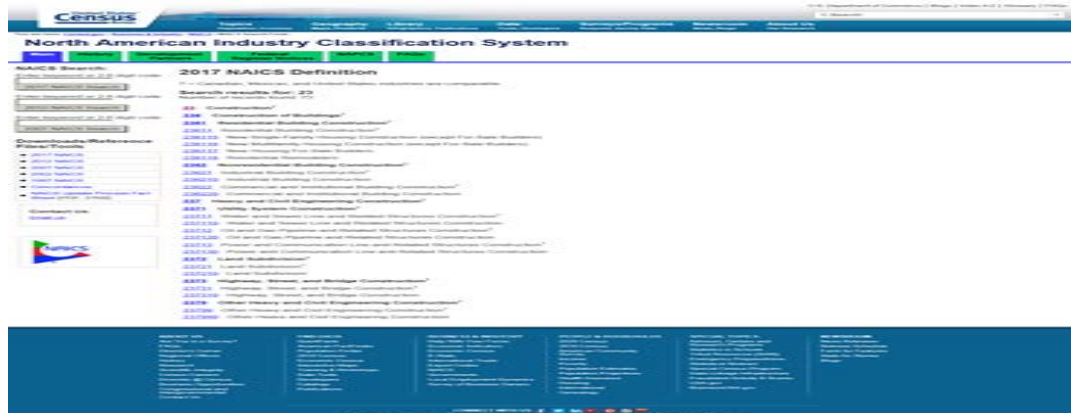

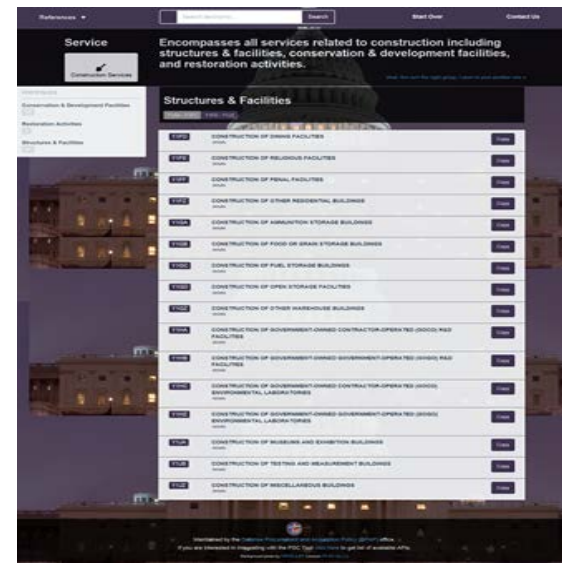
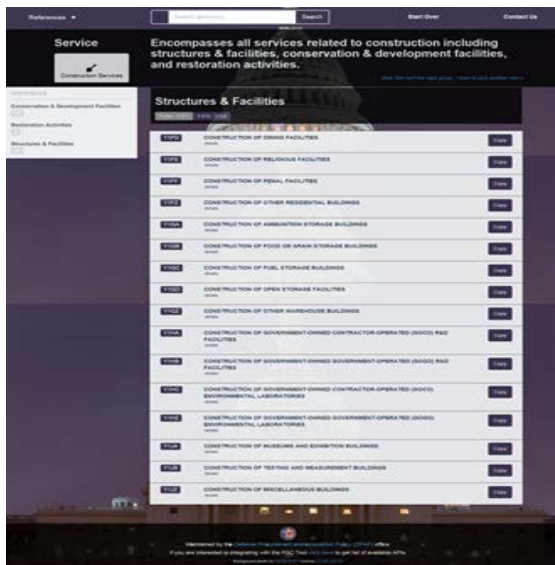
