



General

1. The ADF Women's Australian Rules Football team will play against the NSW Police women's team during the AFL's Anzac Round. The game is to be played at Manuka Oval, Canberra, commencing at 1600 on Friday 22 April 2022. The Anzac Challenge match is the pinnacle of selection for women's ADF Australian Rules Football players.

Aim

2. The aim of this instruction is to detail the administrative arrangements to enable the successful conduct of the activity.

Overview

3. The activity period is from 18 Apr to 23 Apr 22 and includes a training camp, public relations events, the conduct of the main game and return to unit of all players and officials.

Appointments and Responsibilities

- 4. **Appointments**. The key appointments for the conduct of this activity are:
- a. Activity Sponsor BRIG David Smith (ADFAR Chairman)
- b. Activity Coordinator s47E(c)&(d)
- c. Communications and PR s47E(c)&(d)

- 5. All appointments are to ensure the safe and responsible conduct of the activity with particular consideration to the guidelines articulated in the refs.
- 6. **Responsibilities**. The specified tasks for each appointment are outlined. However, further implied tasks may be necessary.
- The Activity Sponsor (AS) has executive authority and is responsible for the oversight of the activity.
- b. Activity Coordinator (AC) is the ADFAR manager for the activity and is responsible for the following:
 - (1) Co-ordination of the activity, including liaison with the NSW Police team and the GWS Giants.
 - (2) Financial management of the activity in liaison with the ADFAR Treasurer.
- c. The PR Officer is responsible for:
 - (1) Communications and PR activities IAW with the ADFAR Strategic Communications plan, liaison with NSW Police, AFL NSW/ACT, the GWS Giants and the AFL.
 - (2) Liaison with internal Defence organisations to effect the communications and PR plan.
- d. The Senior Coach is responsible for:
 - (1) Conduct of the activity.
 - (2) Appointment of Assistant coaches.
- e. The Team Manager (TM) is responsible for:
 - (1) The administration of the team.
 - (2) Liaison and assistance to the AC for accommodation, transport, training facility requirements, support staff arrangements, medical support and team management.
 - (3) The management of team support staff.

- (4) The appointment of timekeepers and interchange officials.
- f. The Umpire Coordinator (UC) is responsible for:
 - (1) The administration of the umpires. Administrative support should dovetail in with the All Stars arrangements where possible.
 - (2) Ensure the ADF is represented well with appropriately qualified field, boundary and goal umpires for the match.

Coordination

- 7. **Selection.** The ADF Team was selected at the conclusion of the ADF National Championships on Sat 19 Mar 22. The selection committee was led by the ADFAR selection officer with a representative from each attending Service team. The team is listed at annex A. All selected members will receive ADF representative apparel.
- 8. **Reporting.** All members of the team are to report to the TM at Building C98 at RMC NLT 1200 on Mon 18 Apr 22. Members will be released to RTU on Sat 23 Apr 22, following positive handover of rooms back to the TM.
- 9. **Training Camp.** Members are considered to be on duty for the period of the activity. Players and officials will be accommodated and rationed at RMC-D from the lunch meal on Mon 18 Apr 22 until Sat 23 Apr 22. The coaching team is responsible for securing appropriate training facilities through the TM.
- 10. **Uniforms.** ADFAR is responsible for the procurement and supply of team uniforms for players and officials that include an on-field and off-field option. All members are to be appropriately attired throughout the activity so as to maintain the professional image of the ADF. Black tailored pants or skirts will be required for formal activities.
- 11. **Incidentals.** ADF Sports Council policy is that incidentals are not to be paid from ADFSC funding. However, parent units may support those individuals attending using local funding arrangements.
- 12. **Functions.** All players are to attend activities outlined in the Daily Program which will be provided at the start of the training camp. This includes a dinner at RMC-D on Wednesday 20 Apr and the presentation on Fri 23 Apr 22 following the main game. Any requests for leave are to be made through the Senior Coach.
- 13. **Umpires.** The Umpires Coordinator (UC) is to select umpires from the National Carnival. The UC, in consultation with the AC, is responsible for all administrative action in regard to movements, accommodation, rationing, uniforms etc. for the umpire group. Under the direction of the UC, umpires are to conduct a training camp. The administration of the umpire group is to be centrally coordinated by the UC.

- 14. **Match Day.** The AC will provide a full run sheet for the main game day, which will be provided to the NSW Police Women's Team Coach and Manager NLT 18 Apr 22.
- 15. **On Field Support.** The Team Manager and Coach will identify suitable personnel within the team to act as runners for the game.
- 16. **Medical Support.** The camp will be supported by a physiotherapist, senior medic, medic and strapping and massage staff. A civilian paramedic will provide support on game day. In case of severe injury during a training session, the TM is to call 000. All other injuries will be attended by the medical support team. The medical team, in consultation with the AC, are responsible for ensuring a suitable quantity of sports and first aid supplies are available for the duration of the activity.
- 17. **Movement and Transport.** The Assistant Team Manager, s47E(c)&(d) in consultation with the AC, is to make all necessary arrangements for flights and movements of all participants for the activity using Defence travel booking processes with ADFAR Treasurer sign-off. Transport (white fleet) arrangements are to be coordinated and booked by the Assistant Team Manager with the AC assistance if required.

Administration

- 18. **Sponsors**. The AS is responsible for inviting ADFAR sponsors to attend the game and associated formal functions.
- 19. **Public Relations.** The PR Officer is to ensure a DEFGRAM is released prior to the games, and an article covering the activity is completed for the Defence newspapers, along with social media support throughout the activity.
- 20. **Activity Budget.** The budget for the activity is to be managed by the AC and Treasurer, conducting reconciliation on completion of the activity in a timely fashion. Financial delegations are only held by AS and the Treasurer.

Conclusion

21. The ADF Women's Team vs. NSW Police Women's Team match is the culminating event for the best Australian Rules Football players in the ADF. It is the first time in the history of ADF Australian Rules that our women's All Stars have had the opportunity to play a curtain raiser game on the national stage during the ANZAC Round. This game is therefore very significant for both the participants and the ADF more broadly; it is the culmination of many years work and ADFAR is very proud that our women now have the same opportunity our men's All Stars have enjoyed during the ANZAC Round for many years. All activity participants are to embrace this opportunity to ensure the successful conduct of the camp and positive outcomes for the match.
