



Major General Jeremy King, CSM

Head Joint Aviation Systems



Major General King enlisted in 1989 and was later commissioned to the Royal Australian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers Corps. Throughout his thirty years in the Army, Major General King has held a range of staff, capability, career management, and command appointments.

Major General King's operational experience includes as a Troop Commander on Operation BEL ISI II in Bougainville and Operation TANAGER in Timor-Leste, and as Officer Commanding the maintenance element in support of Chinook operations in Afghanistan. He also deployed on Operation ASLAN as the Chief Logistics Officer (S4) for the United Nations Mission in South Sudan.

Major General King's regimental experience was in 4th Regiment Royal Australian Artillery, 1st Aviation Regiment, and 6th Aviation Regiment, culminating in command of the 7th Combat Service Support Battalion from 2012-2014. Throughout Major General King's career in the Army he has served as a Design Engineer, Program Manager, Project Director and a Director General within Capability Acquisition and Sustainment Group (CASG). On promotion to Brigadier in 2017, he was appointed as the Director General Army Aviation Systems Branch in CASG. In 2020 he was posted to Army Headquarters as the Direct General Platforms responsible for the Dismounted Combat, Land Mobility and Support and Land Combat Vehicles Programs as well as the Land Training and Simulation capability. In August 2022, he was promoted to Major General and appointed as Head Land Capability before moving to CASG in February 2023 to assume the role of Head Joint Aviation Systems.

Major General King holds a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering, a Master of Business Administration, and a Master of Engineering Science (Electrical). Major General King was appointed as a Fellow of the Institute of Engineers Australia in 2015 and was appointed as a Chartered Engineer in 2004.
